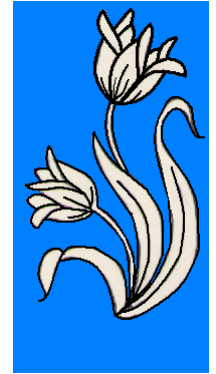


# Brecknock Decorative & Fine Arts Society



## Thursday October 20<sup>th</sup> 2011 BLETCHLEY PARK, MILTON KEYNES

A chance to visit Bletchley Park, Milton Keynes, which is the historic site of secret British code-breaking activities during WWII and birthplace of the modern computer.

After coffee on arrival, our personal guides will take us on a tour of the outside of the war time buildings where visitors are given a detailed history of the site and its code-breaking activities. After a cottage pie or lasagne/profiteroles lunch, (wine extra), we will then be taken to the museum, which depicts the incredibly complex processes of interception, decryption, translation, interpretation and analysis that were needed to produce the vital intelligence that proved so important in ending the war. The day will end with tea and cakes before returning to Brecon.

The transport will leave Brecon (McCarthy's Home) car park at 7.30 am, collecting others from Crickhowell central bus stop (outside Jehou) at 8.00 am and Abergavenny Bus Station at 8.10 am. We will arrive at 11.00 a.m. We hope to leave Bletchley Park at 4.00 pm., arriving back at respective venues at approx. 7.00 pm and 7.30 pm. Price will be £40 per person ( £45 for non-members).

Places will be on a first come first served basis and Members will be given priority over non-members, with places for non-members available only if the trip is under-subscribed. Your place will not be secured until your form and cheque have been received. Cheques will be presented one month before the trip and from then on refunds will only be given in the event of cancellation at the Committee's discretion.

Please note that whilst there is Member to Member liability insurance, BDFAS does not have insurance cover for loss or personal injury and if you want this we suggest you take out your own insurance.
